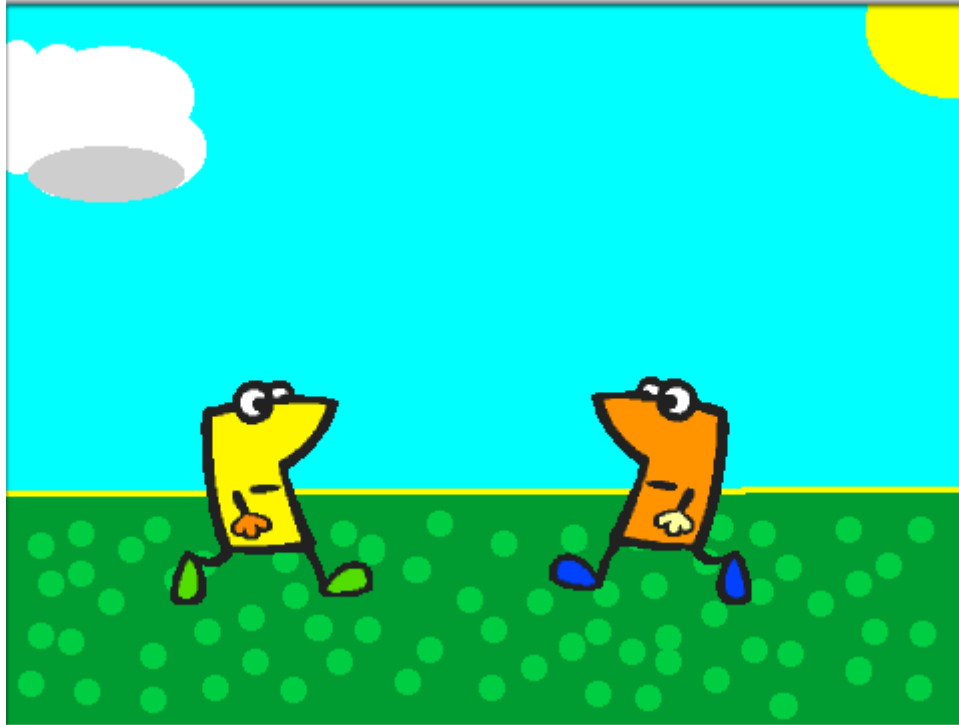


Story Telling Assignment



Create a "three act play" using Scratch. In simple terms a three act play is one with three scenes. A scene in Scratch is represented by the stage. There should be three different 'stages' (scenes) in your play. The characters in the scene above are in an open field.

| Dialog | - The "actors" must talk with each other |
| Action | - Actors may move (optional different costumes) |
